NOTICE AND CONSENT UNDER THE PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT 2010

The Personal Data Protection Act 2010 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), which regulates the processing of personal data in commercial transactions, applies to Institut Jantung Negara Sdn. Bhd. and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as “our”, “us” or “we”).
