- On occasions provide pharmaceutical care in Medication Reconciliation areas, INR Clinic, and Multidisciplinary Clinic/s.
- On weekends support supply medications to outpatients or inpatients or patient care areas.

- Participate in educational and training activities for professional development.
- Perform inventory control & monitoring.
- Perform other duties assigned by the supervisor.
