- To maintain medical records of employees during the course of employment and post termination.
- To develop SOPs and work of instructions pertaining to health issues/ related activities.
- To advice medical removal / job modification if employee not fit to work.
- To investigate cause of the Occupational Disease and Poisoning, and recommendation for remedial actions, help facilitate treatment, rehabilitation, disability assessment, return to work and/or compensation.
- To finalize risk stratification for COVID-19 cases and liaise with KKM as per guidelines.
- To involve in development of Occupational Health & Safety management system for the organization.
- To support the CSM team working towards improving the customer experience and increasing customer loyalty and other ad hoc task assigned by the management.
