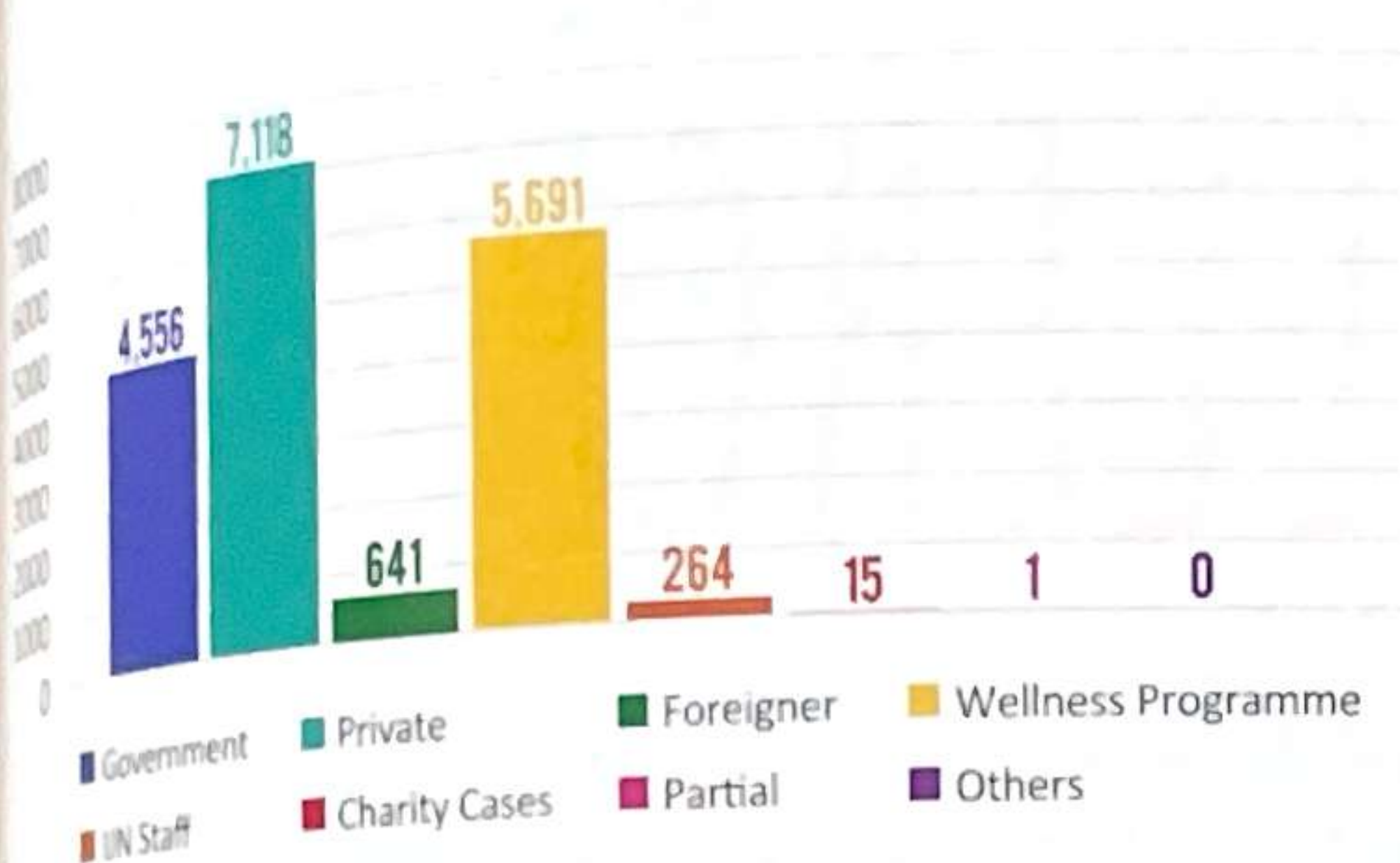
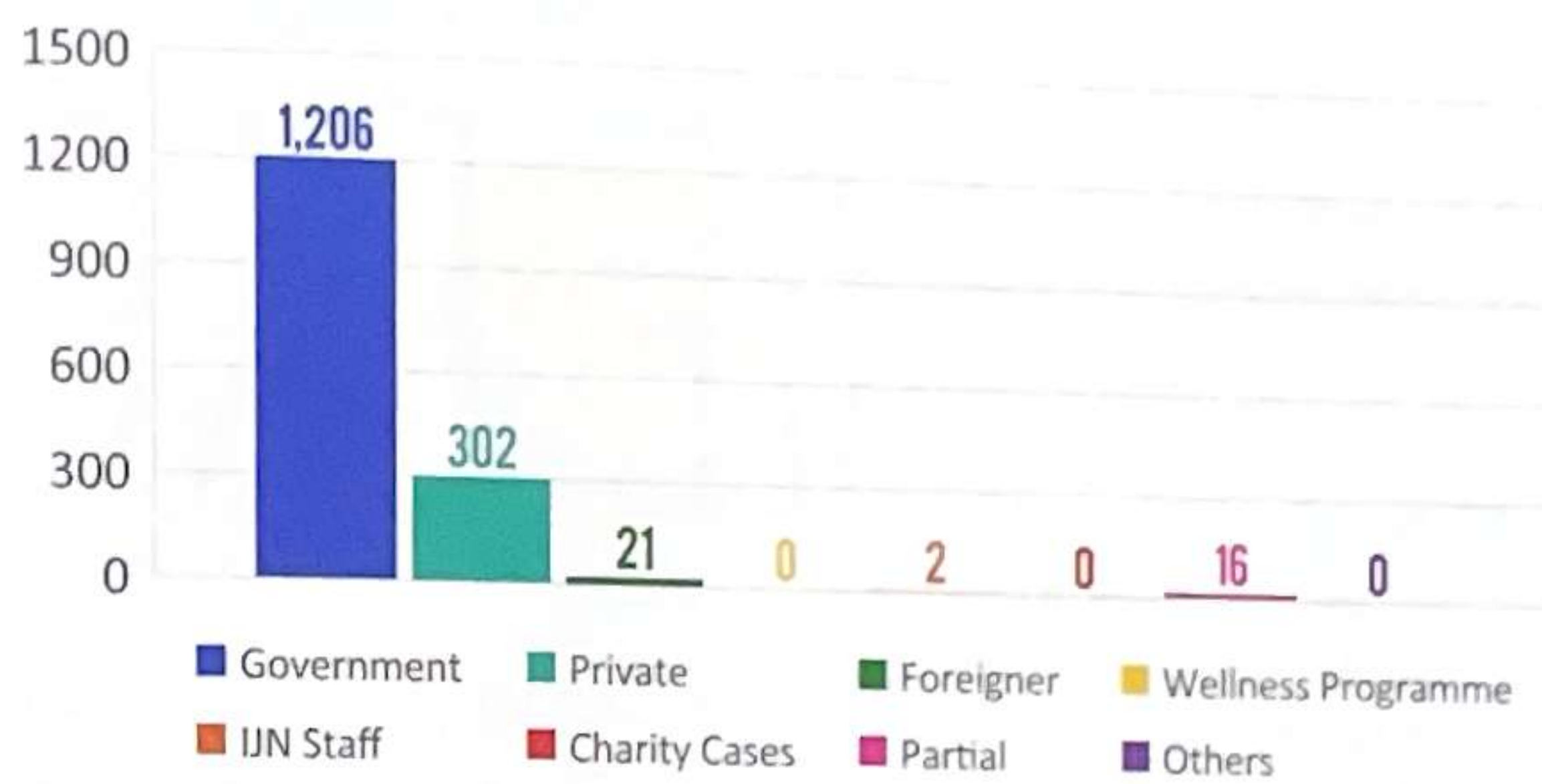

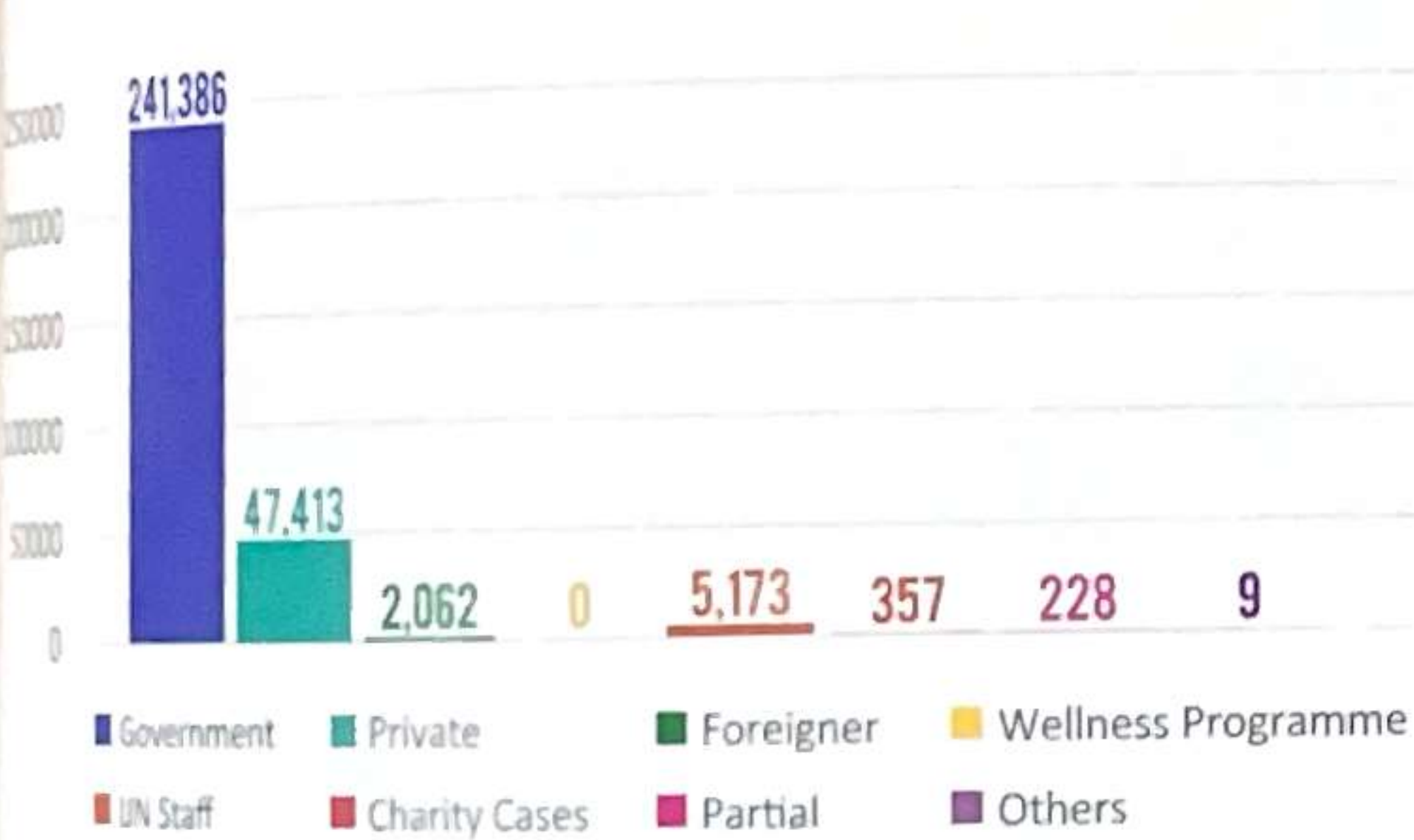
Outpatient
total number of new case



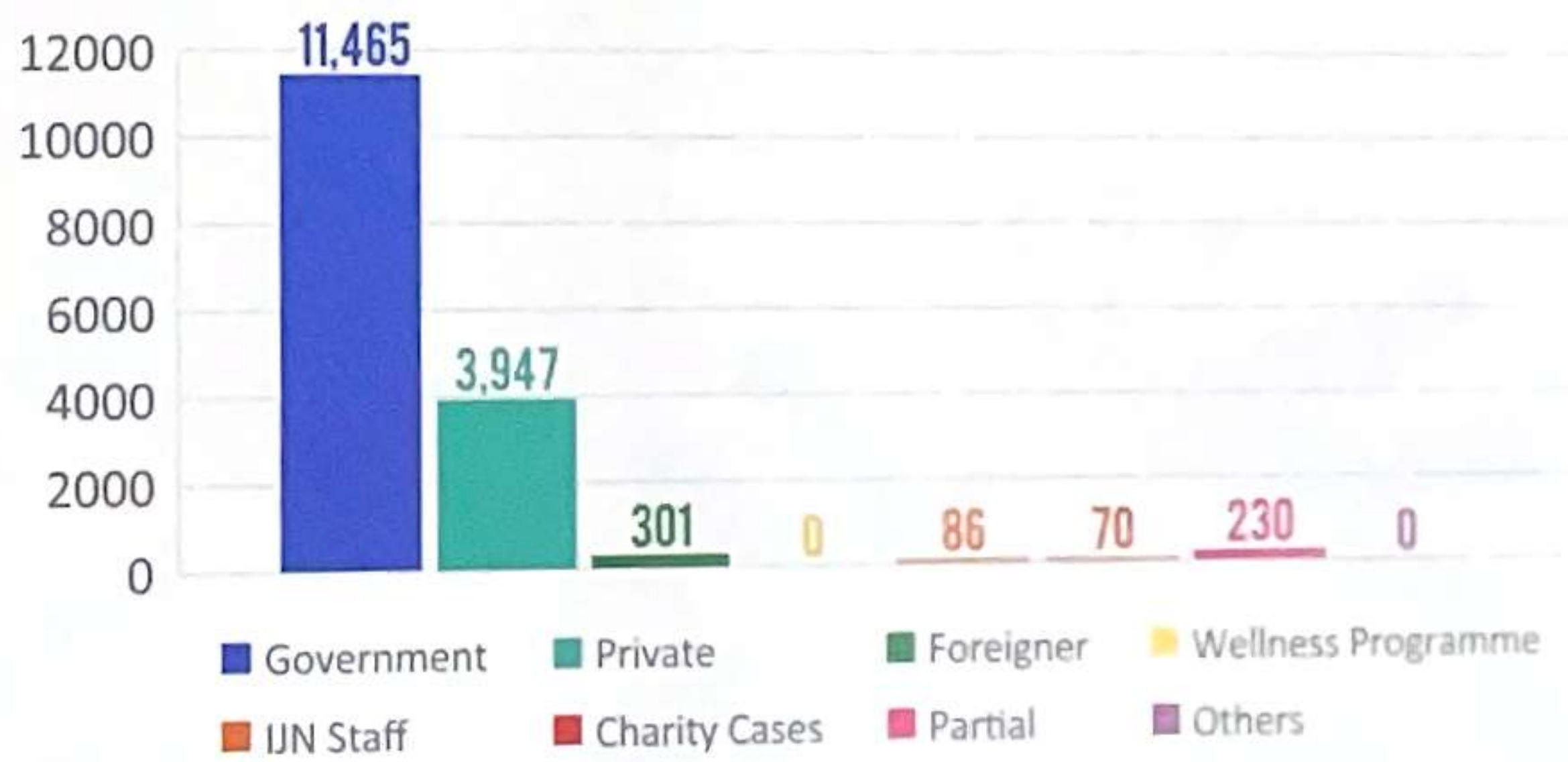
Inpatient

IJN recorded a productive 2017 reflected by its overall outpatient and inpatient visitors with a grand total of approximately 350,000 patients welcomed through its doors.



Outpatient cases

For new cases, private patients make up the largest number of outpatients with 7,118 patients. This number is followed by the second largest group of outpatients at IJN's wellness centre at 5,691 patients. Government outpatients make the third largest number of outpatients while their follow up cases of 241,386 made the largest category of follow up outpatients. There were 641 new foreigner patients with 2,062 of them coming in for follow up cases. Overall, outpatient follow up cases total at 296,628.

Inpatient cases

The largest number of new inpatient cases came from the government sector at 1,206. This sector makes up the largest number of follow up cases at 11,465 patients. New private inpatient cases are only a quarter of the government sector's numbers while new follow up private cases stand at 3,947 patients. The number of new foreigner inpatient cases remain modest at 21 with 301 follow up cases. There were 15 outpatient and 70 inpatient charity cases, reflecting IJN's commitment to serve the poor.
