

5 FACTS ABOUT WOMEN & STROKE



Fact #1:
While the risk of stroke does increase with age, stroke can occur at any age, including in young women.



Fact #2:
Pregnancy can increase the risk of stroke, especially in women with certain conditions like preeclampsia.



Fact #3:
Stroke symptoms can be similar in both men and women, although women may also experience unique symptoms such as hiccups and sudden behavioral changes.



Fact #4:

Gender does not determine the ease or difficulty of stroke recovery.

A family history of stroke can increase a woman's risk of having a stroke. *♥*
